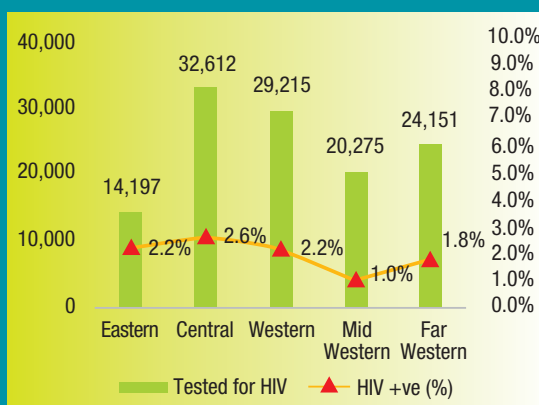
Background about HIV Testing and Counseling (HTC) in Nepal

- 🚫 HIV Testing and Counseling was first started in Nepal in 1995.
- 🚫 HIV Testing and Counseling is the entry point for overall HIV care services. It is provided free of cost to the key populations at higher risk and general population from all over the country.
- 🚫 As of the Nepal HIV Investment Plan 2014-2016, community testing approaches have adopted in Nepal as community based testing and treat competence.
- 🚫 There is a National Guidelines for Testing and Counseling of HIV in Nepal, first developed in 2003, and updated in 2007, 2009 and 2011.
- 🚫 There are 239 service sites for HIV testing and counseling, including 97 government sites.

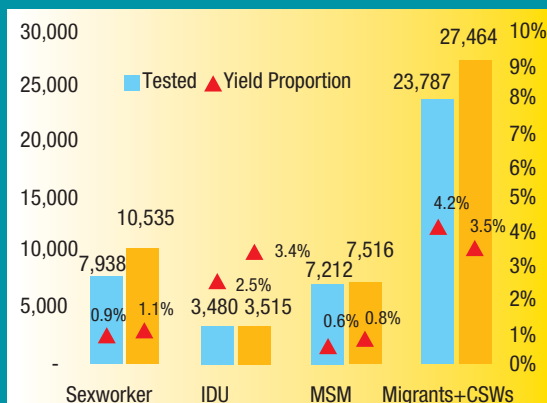

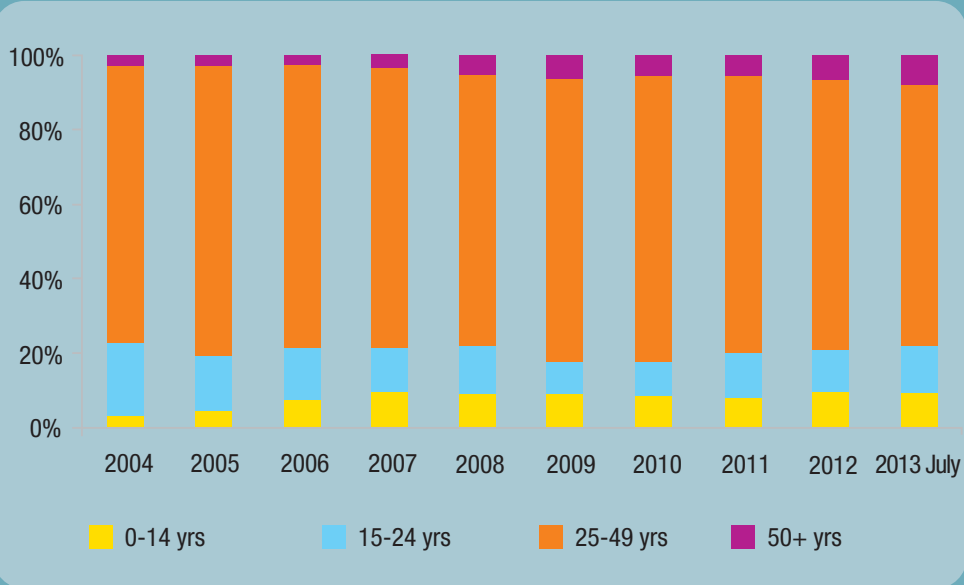
**Figure 1:

 in Nepal, 2012**



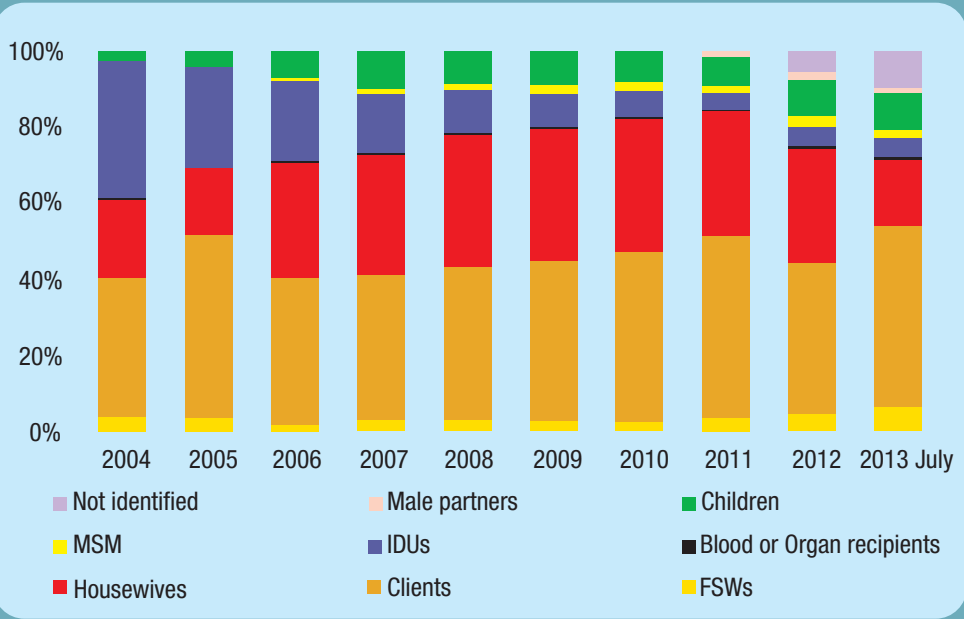
**Figure 2:
