✘ Annual estimated pregnancies in 2012:	766,156
✘ Mothers requiring PMTCT in 2012:	866
✘ Total pregnant women tested for HIV during 2006-July 2013:	597,729
✘ Total HIV +ve pregnant women during 2006-July 2013:	910
✘ Total deliveries by HIV+ve mothers during 2006-July 2013:	686
✘ Total mothers received ART and Prophylaxis during 2006-July 2013:	599

PMTCT in Nepal, 2013

- Comprehensive PMTCT service started in Nepal from February 2005.
- Government provides free ARV drugs and follow-up testing for the baby free of cost from 18 months.
- There are 60 PMTCT sites in 35 districts, of which 7 districts (Achham, Kailali, Sunsari, Dailekh, Baitadi and Dadeldhura) implementing CB-PMTCT programme.
